Clallam County seeks comments on a Shoreline Permit Application from Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe for a Commercial Aquaculture Operation **within the boundary of Dungeness National Wildlife Refuge**. The proposed operation is located on 50 acres of tidelands in the northeast corner of Dungeness Harbor. It includes up to 80,000 on-bottom bags on 20 acres and an additional 14 acres of on-beach oysters. The County's SEPA threshold determination will be issued at least 14 days prior to the public hearing, and their staff report will be available 7 days before the hearing..
