If there is minimal impact to refuge wildlife, habitat and resources from activities described in the monitoring plan, it is likely that a Compatibility Determination could be written, public comment completed, and the determination signed within 90 days of completion of the monitoring plan.

I wanted to acknowledge that the Clallam County Hearing Examiner's Decision on the Request for Reconsideration does indeed state that the MOU be with Olympic Peninsula Audubon Society **or** the USFWS. I inadvertently referenced the language from the original decision document during our discussion.
