LET'S SAVE OUR DUNGENESS REFUGE FROM INDUSTRIALIZATION

A sign waving event is scheduled for Saturday, October 2nd, 10am to 3pm near the Refuge. Please contribute time that morning or afternoon. Show up and make the public and media take notice of the beginning of our national wildlife refuges being commercialized. Let's not let it happen! We can't allow the refuge birds to lose 50% of their primary feeding grounds to a CAFO/concentrated animal (oyster) feed lot, the loss of eelgrass the salmon and Black Brants depend on, and plastic covering the Refuge's bottom lands.

The weather will be pleasant. A good day for the event. After, you can hike

through the county park or walk the Refuge Spit.

**Take Highway 101 to Kitchen-Dick.
Head north until it deadends at
Lotzgesell. Turn right on to Lotzgesell.
The County Park-Refuge area is a short
distance from the turn. You can park in
the county park area. We will stand and
sign-wave on the south side of the road
and will have signs.**
