DNR's policy is to require the tenant to mark the boundaries of the property with piling monuments or other markers of a permanent nature. DNR will require the Tribe to mark the boundaries upon executing a lease agreement with them and that may require the Tribe to have their surveyor go out and install those markers.

All this being said, we will have the GPS/GIS technology available to us on the beach when we are out there next week which will give us a pretty good understanding of where the boundaries are.
