Nanette and Christine,

Yesterday, Wendi had her first meeting with Martha in her new DD position. In follow-up, Wendi asked me for an update on Dungeness. Due to our collective interest in moving this

forward as expeditiously as possible, I grabbed time with her today at 10:00 PT. I added you to this invitation (along with Cynthia, Karen Cogswell, and Scott Aikin).

I plan to outline the same background we provided to Martha on May 31, with the following updates:

- Subsequent meeting (June 9?) in DC with Chairman Allen, HQ SOL, AS IA Newland, and Martha - while I have not had a chance to talk with Martha, my understanding is that there were no specific actions from this meeting;
- June 16 email from Martha to Sarah Krakoff asking if there are any other legal options we have not considered - I have seen no response other than Sarah's acknowledgement of the request;
- July 1 request from the JST to Scott Aikin requesting initiation of negotiations to transfer management of Dungeness to the JST under Title IV of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (attached) - The Service has provided no response to this recently received letter, but I understand there are formal timelines triggered by such requests and I hope to get further clarification this morning.

I hope you are able to attend the discussion this morning, but I understand if you have a conflict and we will not doubt be reconvening on this topic again later this week.
