Acting Notes August 22-26, 2022

8/22/2022 Attended Chiefs Check in, RD call, 1330 Refuges RO Senior Leadership call.

8/23/2022 Justin Sexton responded to Kate Norman (Acting RD) about questions about the Categorical Exclusion Checklist for Nepa Compliance for Tonquin Wetlands Tualatin River National Wildlife Refuge.

8/24/2022 Brent Lawrence from External Affairs asked me to review a press release on opening public access at Wapato Lake NWR. Area Sup Stenvall recommended that we hold off until after Friday's briefing with Hugh. **8/26/2022** After our call Stenvall gave the green light to release the info with one correction on the date of the opening date.

The tribe wanted the list of what is IFF sometime in September. There was concern about the short time to compile and define what is IFF. Hugh recommended that we ask for an extension soon so that it does not appear that we are delaying. The team discussed having some reoccurring meetings to discuss. End

Rebecca gave some background on the Refuge and issues with the levy system. Rebecca indicated the plan is opening the Refuge to the public officially on October 15th, 2022, the public will have total access from February to September. TPart of the Refuge trail system will be closed starting in September. The Refuge will be open only to migratory bird hunting in December and January. Rebecca estimated that work will be complete on repairing the levy system within five years and the Refuge will reevaluate the public use at that time.
