- Can you spell out qualifications for the FWS staff listed and the POC's for each of the partners?
- Can the project still be achieved if the ROD is pushed back a year?
- Will apply bait at the labeled rate of 16 lbs/acre. Will you still be in compliance with the label with the 50% overlap areas of application? What is the correct wording for this (i.e. what wording did they use for the Desecheo NWR rat eradication?).
- What public outreach efforts will go on during and after implementation?
- What will be done to ensure the project has at least a 90% chance of success?
- How often do trespass boats arrives?
- How did the mice originally arrive?

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
