Attached is the most recent plan. Major changes were made to the "SCOPE" section. A few lingering questions can be found in comments on the side bar. Allow me to highlight the more relevant changes:

- i. More complete list of trainings
- ii. Biosecurity protocol
- iii. Haze + monitor sectors identical
- iv. Sectors also more realistic, more refined
- v. Greater detail on how to accomplish goals of testing methods and successful hazing
- vi. 4 phase approach to monitoring and hazing
 - 1. Monitoring of gulls and pinnipeds prior to hazing team arrival (PRBO)
 - 2. Hazing with passive methods—daytime gulls tolerated
 - 3. Combined methods—no gull tolerance
 - 4. Pyrotechnics
- vii. Incident Advisory Group added
- viii. Safety plan in the making—a finalized document will be sent once complete; expected Nov 1.

I don't expect you all to reread the whole plan, but if you could look over the "SCOPE" section and provide any feedback on major changes by **OCTOBER 26, 2012**, it would be much appreciated. As always, I stand ready to answer whatever questions you may have.
