

Closed to Harvest

Emperor Goose

Qamgaangiġ - Qagmangiġ - Nacaullek - Neqlleq - Leghelleq - Ligliqpak - Mitilgruag

- The population of emperor geese has declined and prompted a closure as agreed to in the Alaska Migratory Bird Co-Management Council and Pacific Flyway Council Management Plans.
- Emperor geese are closed to ALL harvest (birds and eggs) in 2026 and will remain closed until the population increases to a level where harvest may resume.
- The closure includes the fall-winter season.
